**RESOLUTION TO ISSUE A NEGATIVE DECLARATION UNDER THE
STATE ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY REVIEW ACT
FOR THE
TOWN & VILLAGE OF DELHI JOINT COMPREHENSIVE PLAN
For February 14, 2012 Delhi Town Board Action**

WHEREAS, on behalf of the Town and Village of Delhi, the TOWN & VILLAGE OF DELHI JOINT COMPREHENSIVE PLAN was developed by the Town & Village of Delhi Joint Comprehensive Plan Committee together with the consultant, River Street Planning and Development; and

WHEREAS, the TOWN & VILLAGE OF DELHI JOINT COMPREHENSIVE PLAN includes a Community Profile of existing conditions including demographics, housing, local economy, land use, land management, natural resources and environment, transportation and infrastructure, historic and recreational resources, and community services; and

WHEREAS, the second component of the TOWN & VILLAGE OF DELHI JOINT COMPREHENSIVE PLAN is an Action Plan which includes a vision statement, set of goals, and identified actions to achieve the goals and vision; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that as lead agency pursuant to 6 NYCRR Part 617.7, the Town of Delhi finds that preparation of the TOWN & VILLAGE OF DELHI JOINT COMPREHENSIVE PLAN will not have a significant adverse impact on the environment and authorizes the issuance of a Negative Declaration of the Type I Action. The reasons for this determination are:

- (1) that the action involves preparation of a program and does not involve any physical alterations or activities on land within the Town; and
- (2) that the Town of Delhi and the other involved communities require that all activities and projects resulting from the completed Comprehensive Plan are individually required to conform with the State Environmental Quality Review Act pursuant to 6 NYCRR Part 617.
