

Local Law No. __001__ of 2023
Town of Delhi County of Delaware

A Local Law Changing from Elected Board of Assessors to Single Appointed Assessor for the Town of Delhi, Delaware County, New York

Section 1. Intent, Authority

The purpose of this Local Law is to permit the Town of Delhi, New York to change from an elected Board of Assessors to a single appointed Assessor. It is adopted pursuant to New York Real Property Tax Law Section 328 and New York Municipal Home Rule Law Section 10.

Section 2. Termination of Terms of Current Assessors

The terms of office for the present elected Assessors for the Town shall terminate on **March 31, 2023** and from and after that date shall be one appointed Assessor for the Town.

Section 3. Appointment and Term of Office of Appointed Assessor

As set forth in Section 310 of the Real Property Tax Law. The single appointed Assessor shall be appointed by the Town Board. The term of office for the initial appointed Assessor shall be **the remaining current 6 year term through September 30th 2025.**

Section 4. Severability.

The invalidity of any clause, sentence, paragraph or provision of this Local Law shall not invalidate any other clause, sentence, paragraph or part thereof.

Section 5. Repealer; Supersession

All Local Laws or Ordinances or parts of Local Laws or Ordinances in conflict with any part of this Local Law are hereby repealed.

Section 6. Referendum Clause

This Local Law shall not be subject to mandatory or permissive referendum.

Section 7. Inconsistency

All other Local Laws and Ordinances of the Town of Delhi that are inconsistent with the provisions of this Local Law are hereby repealed; provided however, that such repeal shall only be to the extent of such inconsistency and in all other respects this Local Law shall be in addition to such other Local Laws or Ordinances regulating and governing the subject matter covered by this Local Law.

Section 8. Savings Clause

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, work, section or part of this Local Law shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder, thereof, but shall be confined in its operation of the clause, sentence, paragraph,

worked section or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.

Section 9. Effective Date

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the Office of the New York State Secretary of State as provided by law.
